



DoP & CE Mark Certificates

From the 1st July 2013, the Construction Products Regulation (CPR) will come into force. It will be mandatory for any construction product covered by a harmonised European Norm (hEN) containing a 'ZA' annex to have a Declaration of Performance (DoP) and an accompanying CE mark.

Manufacturers wishing to place construction products on the market within the European Economic Area (EEA) are legally obliged to ensure that when the products are placed on the market and put into service that they will allow the finished structure to comply with these seven Basic Works Requirements, as shown below. Thereby demonstrating the products 'fitness for purpose'.

- Mechanical resistance and stability
- Safety in case of fire
- Hygiene, health and the environment
- Safety in use
- Protection against noise
- Energy economy and heat retention
- Sustainable use of natural resources

The requirements of a CE mark are that the product has undergone initial type testing and has a published Declaration of Performance.

Wavin has held CE marks for many years and have undertaken 3rd party product type testing with BSi and BSRIA. All products that are required to have a CE mark before the 1st July 2013 will have them.

Wavin will affix the CE mark to the actual product, and or product packaging. Individual products covered by a CE mark are also identified in the appropriate trade price list. (August 2013 onwards) The specific DoP and CE mark details can be found and downloaded via the links below.

Please note; not all products will bear the CE mark. Only those subject to the CPR and manufactured on or after the 1st July 2013 should. Additionally, in respect of the following product standards the CE mark is not a quality standard, it simply confirms that a product has been manufactured to a performance standard that defines the characteristics of the product.

All applicable products are identified with a CE symbol in the Clay Drainage price list (August 2013 onwards).
